- Date** Saturday, 08 August to Saturday, 22 August 2009
- Host District and Clubs:** R.I. District 1870, located in the western part of **Germany**
Rotary Club of Coesfeld and neighbouring RCs
- Aims:** Promote and experience international understanding and friendship between young adults from various European countries and neighbouring regions
Provide an insight in the thinking of young adults and their culture.
- Participants:** 25 young adults, aged 18 -22 years from invited EEMA and other countries.
From each country 2-3 young adults.¹
- Language:** Participants must have a good working knowledge of English
- Programme:** The programme will cover a range of activities including culture, sightseeing, discussions, sports (bicycle tour, high rope). The cities of Cologne, Essen, Münster and Düsseldorf will be visited and in The Netherlands the city of Winterswijk.
- Lodging:** „Jugendburg Gemen“ (a moated castle for youthwork) in Borken-Gemen
- Costs:** The travel expenses to and from Borken-Gemen must be covered by the participants. They should bring adequate pocket money with them.
- Arrival at/Departure from:** Duesseldorf Airport/Mainstation or Münster-Osnabrück Airport/Mainstation on 8 Aug (arrival), 22 Aug 2009 (departure); Pickup at the Airports/mainstation.
- Insurance:** The participants must be insured against illness, accident and third party damages according to R.I. recommendations
- Registration:** The YEOs of the invited countries/districts are asked to send their applications on international standard forms (STEP-Camp) to the point of contact **not later than 31 May 2009**.
